(Matthew 14:13-21) Jesus and the disciples are on their way to a quiet place to get some rest, but a large crowd followed them.

We see Jesus compassion for people. Jesus was tired, but still he takes time to teach the people and healed them because they were like a sheep without a shepherd. As the evening approached the disciples came to him and said, "This is a remote place, and it's already getting late. Send them the crowd away, so they can go to the villages and buy themselves some food. Jesus replied, 'They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat."

Jesus sends the disciples away to find food, they return with two fish and five loaves. Jesus gives thanks for the food, raises it to heaven blesses it



and gives it to the disciples to give out. Everyone eats and there is enough left over to fill twelve baskets.

The lesson we learn from this miracle is that Jesus is ultimate, He provides every need of us and He exceeds. When we pray to God in the name of Lord Jesus our all needs are fulfilled. Scripture messages transform and enrich the lives of children.
