In the month of October 2022, it was a good experience for us to share Good News to young people, of Lahore, Pasrur, Gujranwala, Sahiwal and Islamabad.



God's Little Angels (GLA) Ministry recently launched Discipleship Training program for Youth, in collaboration with First Priority Global Ministry in order to enhance leadership skills. Key purpose of this event was practical implication of First Priority guidebook which has been translated in Urdu language by GLA Ministry. First Priority Global is a Church-based School-focused Student-led ministry that is all about the united Body of Christ in a community using a proven strategy to raise Leaders and reach the next generation with the Hope of Christ.
