Sermon at Bible vacation school - Story of Prophet Jonah

Pastor Shahzaib shared Prophet Jonah's story, when Prophet Jonah was called by God to go to Nineveh and prophesy disaster because of the city's excessive wickedness. Instead he rushes down to Joppa and takes passage in a ship that will carry him in the opposite direction, to Tarshish thinking to escape from God. Of course he could not outrun God. The boat was tossed around in a violent storm and he was thrown overboard after he admitted that he was the cause of the tempest. He was then swallowed by the fish and lives inside its belly for three days. Jonah cries out to God and is spit out of the fish so he can make his way to Nineveh to fulfill his assignment.

Jonah then warns the people of Nineveh that God plans to destroy them unless they repent. The King of Nineveh descends his throne and declares a three day fast, decreeing that no human or beast will taste food or drink water. God observes the Ninevites' acts of contrition and spares the city. Jonah became angry and bitter because God did not destroy them who were Israel's enemy.

God taught him a lesson, when he sat to rest God made a thick vine grow next to the hut, to give him shade. He was glad and sat in its shade. The next day, God sent a worm to eat the vine and hot wind blew and sun beat down mercilessly. Jonah was sad and complained God and wanted to die. God scolded him that he lamented the death of plant that he had not sown or nourished.



This seems to be an example for us all. If even the wicked, non-Hebrew citizens of Nineveh could see the power of God and the consequences of evil, how much more so should we repent and follow God's commandments. Jonah learnt that all men, and women, and little children, whether they know God or not, are precious in the eyes of the God.

We need to rejoice when one obeys God, no matter who or where they are. Hiding or running away from God is not a solution. It is always better to run to God than to try running from Him.

Sunday school - Bible Distribution

Feeding Program:

Skill Training Program:

Students in Village 136 sewing class are nearly at completion stage. This course covered basic sewing and design, cut commercial patterns and students are overjoyed to have gained a long lasting skill. They've learned a variety of designs and can construct various shirt patterns using an appropriate finish. This course also taught them the anatomy of a sewing machine as well as other sewing techniques such as professionally finishing a garment. They are comfortable using a domestic sewing machine and are familiar with the terminology used in the fashion industry.

Their final evaluation and graduation ceremony will be scheduled soon.
