Outreach Event: Amazing Grace during worship

"All the earth will worship You, and will sing praises to You; they will sing praises to your name." (Psalm 99:9)

What a privilege it is to see and hear the young children joyfully giving themselves in songs of praise to God. Children quickly move to a place of trust and abandon in their songs of worship, a place many adults approach with hesitation. Perhaps this is part of the reason Christ said, "You must become as little children to enter the kingdom of God." (Mat 18:3)

There is also a time in our Outreach Meetings where the children offer prayers of thanks and bring their requests for the problems their families are facing.

The outreach meetings are a time when children learn many songs, choruses and hymns based on scripture. Also, there are scripture memorization games.



Pastor Shahzaib offered a message teaching about the miracles Jesus performed. Jesus performed miracles out of compassion for the suffering people. Sewing Center at Chak 136:

Economic empowerment is vital for women. An opening ceremony for new sewing class was held in April. A new of 20 young women got enrolled. Women in this center belong to poor families, some of them work as domestic servants. Through this opportunity these young women will have the opportunity to gain skills for economic empowerment and develop relationship with others who share their hope in Christ. Classes have begun and the teacher has much to share. Students are happy to learn sewing skills they may use to support themselves and their family.
